Jack Conway was first elected Attorney General in November 2007 and re-elected November 2011. He has vigorously prosecuted child predators and has cracked down on internet crimes. He created a Cyber Crimes Unit to investigate online solicitations of minors, scams and identity theft. In 2009, his HB315 was passed which brings Kentucky law up-to-date with a degree in public policy from Duke University, went to night school at University of Louisville's law school and graduated with honors from the National Law Center at George Washington University. He is a member of NAAG, Democratic Attorney General's Association, Kentucky Bar Association and Louisville Bar Association. He is married to Elizabeth Davenport Conway and is the father of two daughters, Eva and Alex.
