**This Week's Speakers...**

The speakers for the day were Hannah Helm with the Woods and Water Land Trust and Charlie Jones, local attorney and president of the Trust. The Trust had its origin when J. B. Marston agreed to sell 150 acres to the trust in the Peaks Mill area instead of developing it. First Ms. Helm gave a little background on the need for such a Trust. For the most part, woodlands and savannahs are gone today in Kentucky. The importance of having forest blocks and nature areas include species diversity, improved water quality, improved air quality, scenic beauty, and recreational opportunities. Unfortunately, woodlands, wetlands and farmlands are disappearing and with urban sprawl, 130 acres of forests and field are lost every day. When Kentucky became a state, we had 2.2 million acres of wetlands, but less than 300,000 today. 80% of wetlands have been lost, and it is even higher in the Bluegrass. There are also invasive exotic plants brought from other countries. These have no natural enemies and encroach upon native plants. While there are lands owned by the federal and state governments – which helps control urban sprawl – this comprises only 7½ per cent of the lands. Therefore, there is a need for these Trusts to preserve our lands. The Woods and Water Land Trust is a non-profit organization that seeks to work with local landowners to preserve the land's productive value. The goal of the trust is to own and manage lands through conservation easements by designating certain ways land can be used. In return, landowners agree to certain restrictions on the use of their land although they can still live on the land, farm and harvest timber on it, pass it on to heirs, and even sell it. The landowners benefit from this by having their land protected into perpetuity, having the benefit of tax deductions and by having reduced estate taxes.
