This Week's Speaker...

The speaker for the day was Trina Koontz, manager of the Kentucky Employee Assistance Program. She stated that an employer's biggest investment is the employee, yet unfortunately some employers tell their employees to leave their personal problems outside the door. However, personal problems do impact work and job performance and many factors such as domestic issues, emotional and mental problems and substance abuse problems do have an adverse impact. This is expensive both to the employee and employer, and affects one's quality of life. Some employees suffer from depression and some have chemical dependencies and 10% of the work force are beset

with personal problems at any one time. The Employee Assistance Program she oversees is internal within state government and this fact often causes barriers between her agency and those seeking help. Known by the acronym KEEP, the Kentucky assistance program values an employee's confidentiality and refers the employee to those resources which are available to give them help. This program is an employee benefit and it is also low risk because the inquiries can be anonymous. Her agency does stress management training and most private companies now have employee assistance programs. In responding to questions, she stated that her agency does not do advocacy work or mediate with management. They also try to make sure the employee is capable of making the right decision when deciding to file a grievance. This service is only available to Kentucky state employees and their dependents, although most businesses are making employee assistance available.
