**Paula Rutledge** has been director of the Frankfort Chapter of the American Red Cross for 15 years. Her duties include the management of the delivery of all lines of service for the Chapter jurisdiction, including Disaster Preparedness and Relief, Service to the Armed Forces, Blood Collections, Health and Safety Training, and Youth/Community Service programs. She recruits and trains volunteers to assist with many daily chapter services, implements a complete schedule of Health and Safety training programs and as a result received the State Red Cross Employee of the Year award in 2005. She has trained and deployed 27 volunteers to Katrina response in various states in the Gulf area. She has also implemented a successful weekly Bloodmobile at the Chapter. As director, Paula wears many different hats whose bookkeeping responsibilities include managing all the accounting processes, grant reporting requirements, payroll configuration and has taught a variety of classes and courses. She will speak on disaster relief in light of the recent hurricanes as well as the dire financial needs of the Chapter during these critical times.

**This Week's Speaker....**

The speaker for the day was Chief Judge of the Kentucky Court of Appeals Judge Sara Combs. Her talk was in two parts, speaking first about the structure of the court system, and secondly about some of her judicial philosophy. First as to the structure, she stated that to imagine a pyramid with the District Court at the bottom. This is the tier most people encounter who are involved in the court system. The jurisdictional amount is \$4,000 or less, and is concerned with misdemeanor offenses. The next level is the circuit courts, where the jurisdictional amount is greater than \$4,000 and where the serious criminal offenses go like felonies. This is also where Family Court is found. Section 115 of the Kentucky Constitution guarantees one appeal as a matter of right and she sits on the next

level up which is the Court of Appeals. There are seven appellate divisions and the Court of Appeals has two judges per division for a total of 14. There are also seven Supreme Court judges which sit on the top of the pyramid. The majority of cases which go to the Supreme Court are by discretionary review; however there are some appeals of right that go to the top level, such as cases where the defendant has received 20 years or more and capital cases. Concerning her judicial philosophy, she stated that the courts are the watchdogs of the people. As a French philosopher stated from whom Thomas Jefferson received much of his inspiration, sometimes we lose our rights in an hour and do not realize it for a hundred years. It is the duty of the court system to make sure that our laws comply with the federal and state constitutions. Thank you Carol Palmore for a great month of programs.
