This Week's Speaker...

Joel Schrader, the owner and publisher of *Capital Living*, discussed why he started thinking about publishing a newspaper. His background included working with the Central Intelligence Agency and managing a team responsible for providing information on national security matters. He has also worked as a CIA representative in the White House Situation Room with the National Security Council. His duties included generating and researching timely articles, reports and tasking on European leaders and other national

security matters. With his background in news and with the recent news of the market and Wall Street, Joel started thinking about a free newspaper with a positive interest for Frankfort and Franklin County. He started publishing the *Capital Living* newspaper every other Thursday and has over 100 locations that carry the paper. Joel has even delivered it to some subdivisions and downtown Frankfort. He decided to have some flexibility with the paper for his advertisers concerning the date of issue and providing them with a way to advertise by including inserts in the paper. In his first issues, Joel included articles on wine and spirits as well as religious articles from churches in the area. He also wanted it to be a social paper where you would see a picture of someone you knew when you picked one up. Copies are provided to hotels where tourists will receive a positive image of Frankfort. Joel stated citizens are welcome to submit articles they would like to see published. He has a liberal policy with candidates for public office to provide information to the readers but doesn't get into political issues himself. Charities are allowed coverage concerning special events they are planning. Joel has a good working relationship with the local State Journal newspaper. He has been amazed at the positive response from advertisers and the community. The entire paper is on line, and if people want

a subscription, he only charges for the postage and handling. Joel is considering a photography contest in the future and plans to keep the paper local to the Frankfort area.
