Greg Fuchs has been a Frankfort Rotary Club member since 1991 and has participated in the Group Study Exchange hosting since the 1993 exchange with Rotary District 3200 in Kerala and Tamil Nadu, India. In 2004, Greg led his first exchange team to District 4860 Mendoza and San Juan, Argentina. Last April when our club was hosting the Group Study Exchange Team from District 2570 in Japan, Greg led a second team of four young professionals including Barry Burkett from the Thornhill Learning Center and Amanda Murphy-Sanders from the Office of the Attorney General here in Frankfort to District 2570 in Saitama Prefecture, Japan. (Saitama Prefecture is to Tokyo what New Jersey is to New York.) From April 2 to April 29 the team moved through the five Rotary group areas in that district towards Tokyo visiting among other nearby cities Fukaya, Kumagaya, Kawagoe, Tokorozawa and Wako as well as the World Heritage Site at Nikko



in neighboring Tochigi Prefecture and in the end Tokyo. The trip was the first trip to Japan for all the team members and was an excellent introduction to Japanese customs and culture from tea ceremonies to baseball games. Greg will share his experience with the club on November 5.
