This Week's Speaker...

Mr. Kim Menke, Manager of Community Services for Toyota Motor Manufacturing of Kentucky, provided an overview of Toyota and the automobile industry worldwide, in North America (NA), and in KY. He concluded with information on Toyota's efforts to give back to

the community. Internationally, Toyota has 68 manufacturing operations in 28 countries, with 316,000 employees. He described Toyota's NA growth and expansion, which now includes 11 testing/research and development facilities, Toyota NA headquarters in Erlanger KY, 10 auto manufacturing plants with another under construction in Tupelo, MS, and four components plants. Toyota also has over 500 NA suppliers, heavily located in the 1-75 and 1-65 corridors. Auto sales in NA peaked in 2005 with 18.5 million sold in NA. This year, auto sales are projected to be less than 13 million. Toyota sales are down about 28%. The Georgetown plants contain 7.5 million sq. ft. (156 football fields). It's a \$5.4 billion investment with over 7000 team members. Mr. Menke acknowledged the company's debt to its team members and to former Gov. Martha Layne Collins. The Georgetown plant is the most self-contained auto manufacturing plant in NA. However, Toyota has 92 parts suppliers in KY, providing 35,000 jobs, with Toyota spending \$2.5 billion/yr. on parts. Georgetown team members live in 78 of KY's 120 counties. 80% live within an 80-mile radius of the plant. Scott and Fayette County residents combine for about 55 percent of the plant's work force. 209, or 3%, live in Franklin Co. He described

Toyota's corporate citizenship efforts as giving back through volunteerism, community involvement, and philanthropy plus a program of public awareness and education. Toyota provides incentives to its team members who volunteer to help nonprofit organizations. After 75 hrs. of a volunteer's service, Toyota will write a \$200 check to the charity of the team member's choice. Toyota encourages volunteer participation in civic organizations and the school systems. Its' corporate gifts in KY total \$30.6 million through 2007. Its public awareness program includes a one-hour guided plant tour, with advance registration recommended. In public education, it has established an environmental education center in Georgetown and developed age-specific curricula to help teachers, with no charge to the schools.
