This Week's Speaker...

The speaker for the day was Captain Bill McKinley with the Salvation Army. He gave a history of the famous Red Kettle. The idea came about from a 1891 fundraiser in San Francisco where Captain Joseph McFee had seen a crab pot being used on the docks in England to collect funds for the poor. The funds generated by the crab pot on a tripod were used to finance a Christmas party for the poor under the motto "Keep the Pot Boiling." From the West coast the red kettle went to the East coast and to Boston where a Captain McIntyre took it and

raised money for some 150,000 dinners. The red kettle was hailed by newspapers of the day as the newest and greatest fundraising device. In 1901 it was used to finance a mammoth sit-down dinner at Madison Square Garden in New York, and today the famous red kettles are recognized throughout the world. It helps the poor, lonely and ill. Every day we see the services provided by the Salvation Army. One out of ten persons know someone helped by the Salvation Army. The old crab pot has been brought into the 21st century, and even credit cards and debit cards are accepted in some places. Under the slogan "doing the most good" the famous red kettle supports many activities in the community helping the less fortunate.
