This Week's Speaker...

The speaker for the day was Chris Olds, who was sworn in as District Judge on November 24, 2008. He gave the Club a brief overview of his career as an attorney, which included working in the Fayette Commonwealth Attorney's Office, as well as doing *pro bono* work as a Public Defender. He got much trial experience as an attorney and found out that good people often make mistakes and need their lives to be redirected. A defense attorney has an excellent chance to minister in his work. Judge Olds summarized many of the types of cases he will hear in District Court which includes misdemeanors, preliminary hearings in felony cases, small claims cases, traffic court, juvenile cases, probate, and disability jury trials. He stated that 99% of the public wants to obey the laws. He made the observation that if both sides leave angry in a case, he has made the right decision. Judge Olds' judicial philosophy is to remember that he is dealing with real people and their lives and not files. There must be a balance between the rights of the individual and the rights of society to be protected. Therefore, it is vital to be very careful when signing warrants and in reviewing bonds. Above all, everyone coming before his

Court must be treated with respect. There is a need to improve the efficiency of the courts. For example, if a police officer waits all day to be heard in a case when he needs to be on patrol, this raises safety and fiscal issues when one considers his overtime pay. There is a need for cases to be called when other cases are being pre-tried. Judge Olds addressed the drug problem, stating that the majority of crimes such as burglaries and robberies are committed because someone is supporting a drug habit. It all starts with the parents, who need to properly raise their children, teaching them right from wrong behaviors. He would like to extend the Drug Court to District Court and states that the key to preventing crime is to solve the drug problem. Thank you Judge Olds for a fascinating look at the functions of District Court.
