This Week's Speaker...

The speaker for the day was Dr. Jack Early who spoke on the topic "attitudes for our time." Attitudes will determine our altitudes and our willpower will carry us as far as we want to go. If someone thinks something is impossible, it is only impossible to that person. In Wise County, Virginia during the Depression a dentist began writing named Napoleon Hill. He asked to interview Andrew Carnegie and Carnegie turned the tables and started to interview him. Carnegie told him that successful people share much, and he challenged Hill to interview successful people. Hill also interviewed Woodrow

Wilson, who asked Hill to be an adviser. Hill wrote a book entitled "Law of Success." In 1937 he wrote a book titled "Think and Grow Rich." W. Clement Stone read the book and later donated \$1 million to PolioPlus. Hill also advised FDR and invented the saying "We have nothing to fear but fear itself." In this book, he devised four Principles: (1) We need a definite major purpose. Too many people and corporations do not know where they are going. We must always ask what is our reason for being. Stone gave away over \$500 million in his lifetime. (2) We need a Master Mind Alliance with each other as we work toward a common objective. We must work together and cannot do it alone. The United States was founded on this principle. (3) We can learn from adversity. The media only shows worry while this is the time for ingenuity. The media needs to focus on what is right for a change. One example of what is going right is that Rotary is alive and well. (4) We need more enthusiasm. This can express the power from within. When we receive we also must give. Otherwise our lives become stagnant. A phrase to live by is to do everything enthusiastically.
