This Week's Speaker...

The speaker for the day was Franklin County Tourism Director Joy Jefferies, who spoke about the River Front Development which came out of a Governor's Task Force. The project has the support of local representatives and senators and has three goals: (1) Do no harm. She realizes that this is a historic city and that historic preservation is part of the development project; (2) Engineering plans are needed because the river does rise; (3) There is a marketing component here and we do not want just a plan but we need a product that will sell. They have studied other river communities and other river front development plans. Rodney Ratliff donated 4½ acres across from the Capital Plaza Hotel and Jane Beshear made sure that \$150,000 was obtained from the state for a study. This whole process lasted over four years. A consulting firm has been retained and a mapping analysis done. Local realtors, neighborhood associations, and many business leaders were

involved in stakeholder meetings. The concept includes potential hiking and walking trails, conference center, outdoors theatre, restaurant and retail stores. The green space must involve both public and private uses since a revenue base is also needed to support the proposed riverfront development projects.
