



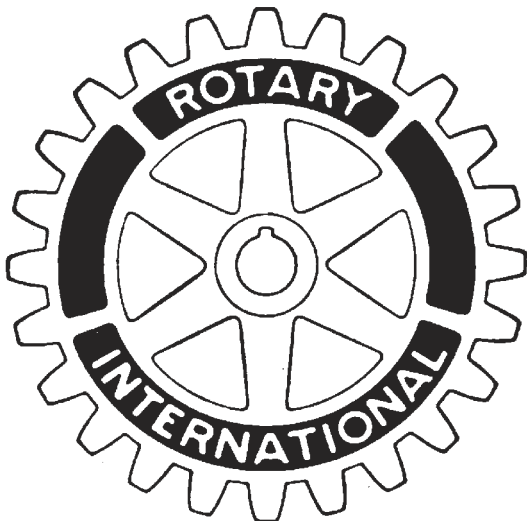
It was good to have Frank Sower with us. He stands with Joyce Honaker. Frank has 63 years of perfect attendance.

Fellow Rotarian **Ron Bryant** is the manager of Waveland State Historic Site in Lexington and teaches history at Lexington Community College. He has also written extensively on Kentucky history. The title of his presentation is "King Solomon of Kentucky." William "King"

Solomon, a Lexington vagrant, became the hero of the 1833 cholera epidemic. Due to his efforts to bury the victims of the epidemic, he saved the lives of many others.
