**This Week's Speaker...**

The speaker for the day was Ken Wilson who is a Social Worker for Hospice of the Bluegrass. He spent time in the Peace Corps in Malawi and spoke about the Frankfort sister hospice in Vereeniging, South Africa, known as Wide Horizon Hospice. It was established in 1985 and started out in a garden cottage. This Hospice gives palliative care and ministers to the terminally ill. In 1998, the Karuna Clinic was established, which gives medical care to those living in the Africa bush. It has a full administrative staff and 12 beds, is supported by community gifts and donations and specializes in the care of patients who have HIV/AIDS. 90% of the children with AIDS are in sub-Saharan Africa. Some 22 million persons in Africa have AIDS. Unfortunately, women in Africa have no voice and power. Women must remain faithful to their husbands while the husbands need not remain monogamous. The local culture blames AIDS on witchcraft. The

civilizations in Africa are breaking down due to the epidemic. However, we live in a global community.

Your local Hospice recently had a fundraiser for Hospice overseas and through an auction of baked goods, gift baskets, handcrafted items, and donated services raised \$2,822. Lexington and Cynthiana also raised funds. This money will buy many medical supplies in Africa
