This Week's Speaker...

The speaker for the day was Gill Holland who has produced more than 50 feature films, developed the Green Building in Louisville and founded sonaBLAST! Records. Many of his efforts are socially conscious and promote sustainability. He began his talk by describing the Green Building and how it is healthier than the average office building, which typically has air 30% more polluted than the outside. Buildings contain lead-based paints and other unhealthy chemicals. He showed a clip from his film "FLOW" which discussed the hazards of herbicides such as atrazine. The Green Movement is the greatest of all capitalistic movements and China is far ahead of us. Pesticides are associated with breast and prostate cancer. Atrazine is a lethal herbicide, which appears in rainwater, and Kentucky is in the top three of having this chemical in our water. He also discussed the plastic bottle industry, which removes precious water and pays nothing for it and does nothing to contribute to the local tax base. Also plastic bottles are a non-renewable resource and our streams are being turned into mud flats.
