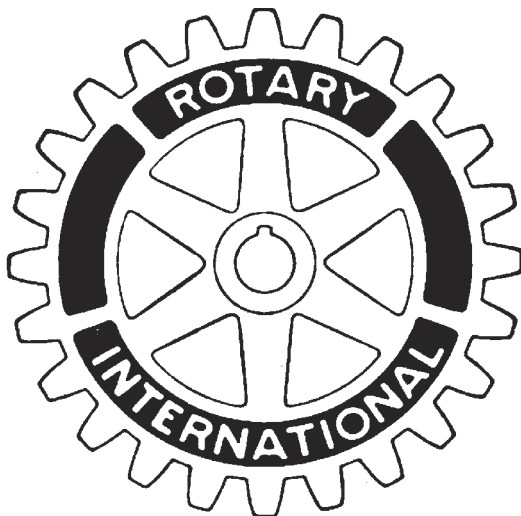
Amy Nance's project is called **Cinderella's Closet**. It provides prom dresses and accessories for young ladies who might otherwise not be able purchase one.

**Janet Holloway** is the co-founder and Executive Director of Women Leading Kentucky, a professional network of women and men committed to helping women lead, learn and achieve. Recent keynote speakers include NBC Today Show's Jean Chatzky; NPR's Michele Norris; author/ photographer Tipper Gore; adventurer Tori Murden; COSMO editor Kate White; authors Sue Grafton and Gail Sheehy; human rights advocate Diana Villiers Negroponte; media and branding expert Robyn Roffer; and many, many more.

Women Leading Kentucky is a 501c3 educational organization, with no membership or dues required. Programs/services promote the importance of developing relationships built on

respect and mutual support, not business cards or sales leads. If you participate/attend any of the programs, you are part of the Women Leading Kentucky network.



The Roundtable Networking Speaker/Luncheon Series, featuring opportunities to meet prominent role models and speakers, are offered on a first-come, first-serve basis to the public. Featured presenters have included Mira Ball, Ball Homes; Joel Pett, cartoonist; Dr. Mary Sias, Kentucky State University; Dr. Lee Todd, UK; Margaret Engle, Washington, D.C. Newseum Director; Rieva Lesonsky, editor, Entrepreneur Magazine; former Governor Martha Layne Collins; KY Supreme Court Judge Mary Noble; Gene Woods, CEO, KY Catholic Health Initiatives; and more.

**COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS:** Since starting the scholarship fund in 2001, more than \$62,000 has been awarded to female students who have a 3.0 GPA, demonstrate leadership abilities on campus and in their communities, and attend a Kentucky college/university. In addition, a special legacy scholarship, in honor of Carrie S. Shumate, is presented each year to a graduating high school senior to attend any school of her choice in the U.S.

**MENTORING:** Both online and face-to-face mentoring are available.

**ROLE MODELS:** It is important to recognize individuals and organizations committed to helping women take leadership positions, as a way of showing "if they can do it, I can too!" The Martha Layne Collins Leadership Award recognizes a woman who's contributed to Kentucky's improvement through her leadership; and the Top Business for Women Award, in partnership with The Lane Report, recognizes a company/ organization for the policies and practices that enable them to attract, retain and advance qualified women.
