Past District Governor **Kay Sharon** will Speak on the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA), A Leadership Development Program for Financially At-Risk 9th Graders

Kay Sharon is a lifelong resident of Hardin County. She grew up on a farm outside Vine Grove and graduated from North Hardin High School. She recently was named a Distinguished Alumni of the Hardin County Schools. A graduate of the University of Kentucky with a BA in English and Western Kentucky University with a MA in guidance and counseling and a Rank I in School Administration, Kay retired in 2004 with 30 years of service with the Hardin County Schools where she was a teacher and director of public relations. Kay has been a member of the Elizabethtown Rotary Club since 1991. She became active in the club immediately, serving as bulletin editor her first two years. She continued to serve on the Board of Directors in various service areas for the next four years and was installed as president for the 1997-98 Rotary year. She served as Rotary Assistant District Governor for two years. In 2006, she served as District Governor
