Former Kentucky governor, lieutenant governor and Speaker of the House **Julian Carroll** returned to the state senate in 2005 to represent the 7th District. Senator Carroll remains a strong champion of education and health care, and advocates expanding Kentucky's economic base. Due to his willingness to do so and his residence in the Capitol City, Senator Carroll serves on more committees than any other legislator. Committee appointments include Economic Development, Tourism and Labor; State and Local Government; Enrollment; Licensing, Occupations and Administrative Regulations; Banking and Insurance; Health and Welfare, and Contract Review. He also serves on a Budget Review Subcommittee on General Government. Senator Carroll is a Frankfort attorney and a lay minister at First Assembly of God in Frankfort. He is a graduate of the University of Kentucky and the University of Kentucky College of Law. The Senator and wife Charlann have four children and seven grandchildren. His district includes Franklin, Anderson, Woodford and the northern portion of Fayette County.

* Listened to report from Nancy Edwards, President-Elect. She reported that the New Member Orientation had a great turnout.

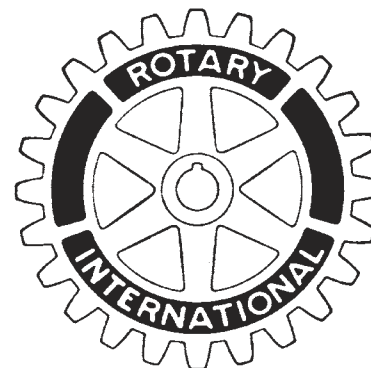
