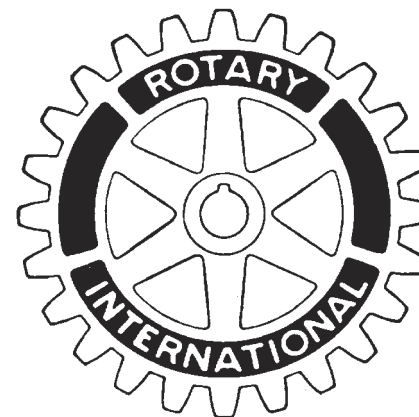

**This Week's Speaker...**

The speaker for the day was Major Roy Hicks with the Salvation Army. The Salvation Army does so much more than ring the bells at Christmas time but also helps with prescriptions, gas, utilities and the Food Pantry. They have a Disaster Canteen which is mobile and out of which they can serve meals. There are youth programs such as the Beginners Band. \$57,000 was raised last year but with only two weeks left in the fundraising they have raised just over \$30,000. They have over 1000 angels this year on their Angel Tree. Rotarians are asked to help in not only ringing the bell but with the Angel Tree as well.
