Anita received a BA in Government and Public Affairs from Morehead State University in 1981 and a JD Degree from UK in 1984. She was admitted to the Kentucky Bar that same year. Anita worked for the Legislative Research Commission from 1985-92 and was Committee Staff Administrator for Elections and

This Week's Speaker....

The speaker for the day was Rep. Jeff Greer, who spoke about some of the pressing issues facing the 2010 General Assembly. He stated that more cuts and more sources of revenue are going to have to be found in order to balance the budget. He is chairman of the largest House committee which is the Banking and Insurance Committee. Many changes on the federal level are going to necessitate changes on the state level as well. One example is health care legislation and how it fares in Congress. Some bills are actually bipartisan, such as the one he is sponsoring on autism. This condition in children is not well covered in health insurance policies and it is the cause of great stresses in families and marriages. He emphasized that good communication is needed between legislators and citizens and that blanket emails are not the way to communicate since they do not get read. He suggested using an old-fashioned method of communication - the telephone. He does return calls.
