**“Climate Change:  
Think Globally, Act Locally”**

Over the years, the majority of scientific data indicate that climate change is accelerating at a rapid pace, glaciers are melting, seas are rising and desertification is striking once verdant areas. Tona Barkley, a local environmental leader, will talk about climate change and highlight some of the latest reports from the scientific community. She will touch upon how governments, businesses and non-governmental organizations can cooperate internationally. Also, Tona will highlight what's happening here in the capital city and how Rotarians can get involved in Lighten Up, Frankfort! Barkley, a Paducah native and Vassar College graduate, retired three years ago from KET, where she served as communications director. In her spare time, she paints, makes quilts and plays old-time & bluegrass music. As a member of Frankfort Climate Action Network, she coordinates Lighten Up, Frankfort, the group's household carbon reduction project, and is the Frankfort representative with Kentucky Sustainable Energy Alliance.
