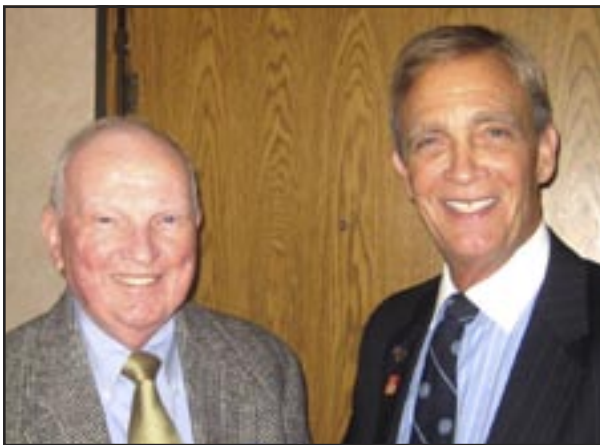

The speaker for the day was local environmentalist Tona Barkley, who spoke about the dangers of greenhouse gases released through carbon dioxide pollutants. In a worst-case scenario, some climatologists are predicting the extinction of most human life at the end of this century due to climate change and global warming. We must take steps now in order to reduce greenhouse gases by 80% by the year 2050. Some steps we can take locally are to call your local, state and national leaders and let them know you want them to act NOW to address climate change, do a home energy audit to make your home more energy efficient, turn the heat down and air conditioning off when not at home, turn off lights and appliances when not in use, wash clothes in cold water, commute by bike, walking and public
