He attended Auburn University and received his DVM degree in 1980. From 1980 to 1984 Southall served in the US Army Special Forces unit assigned to Ft. Benning, GA. After serving in the military he worked in a large-animal private practice in North Alabama. In 1990 he joined USDA and has held position as the Center Director for USDA Animal Import Center in Miami, FL, as the Area Veterinarian in the state of Florida and Tennessee. In 2006 he return back to school and received a MBA from University of Florida. In 2008 he had an opportunity to return home to Kentucky and currently serves as the Area Veterinarian in Charge for USDA Veterinary Service.

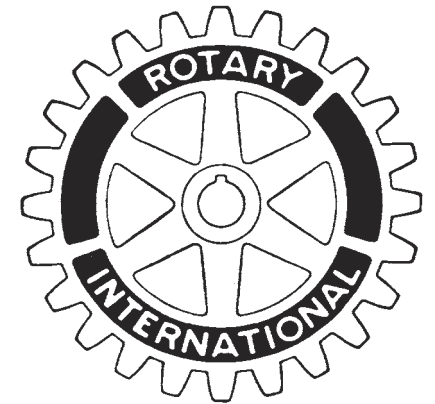
