**This Week's Speaker...**

The speaker for the day was Dr. Robert Southall, who spoke about the USDA, APHIS and Veterinary Services as they relate to the upcoming Equestrian Games. Veterinary Services and the USDA are roughly the equivalent of the Center for Disease Control in Atlanta, except that their focus is in preventing sick and diseased animals from coming into the country. Another purpose is to facilitate international trade. This is important, as several hundred horses are coming in from abroad for the Equestrian Games. The horses fly over in box stalls and there are specific aircraft for this purpose. Horse stewards and even veterinarians fly with the horses to make sure they have food and water and are not injured in transit. A temporary facility is being constructed at

the Cincinnati airport to receive these horses. Some 763 horses are coming in from foreign countries and there are 112 horses from the United States that will be at this event. It costs about \$10,000 per horse to bring a horse in and there is a \$3,000-\$4,000 quarantine fee per horse to screen these horses, part of which cost is paid by the Games to help the owners bring in their horses.
