***Next Week's Speaker...***

**Dr. Mary Evans Sias, Ph.D.** was selected president of Kentucky State University in 2004. She is an advocate for public higher education, especially at black colleges. She is evolving the Land Grant Program into the School of Agriculture, Food Services and Sustainable Systems. KSU's Aquaculture Program is among the top five programs in the nation. Dr. Sias served as senior vice president for student affairs and external relations at the University of Texas at Dallas between 1994 and 2004. She currently serves on the board of directors of the Frankfort YMCA, Frankfort Chamber of Commerce and Leadership Kentucky. Dr. Sias is chair-elect of the board of directors of the Association of Public and Land Grant Universities and serves on the Executive Committee for the APLU. A native of Jackson, Mississippi, Dr. Sias earned her bachelor's degree in sociology from Tougaloo College, where she graduated summa cum laude. She was awarded a Ford Foundation Doctoral Fellowship and pursued her master's and doctorate in sociology from the University of Wisconsin. She also received a master's in business administration from Abilene Christian College.
