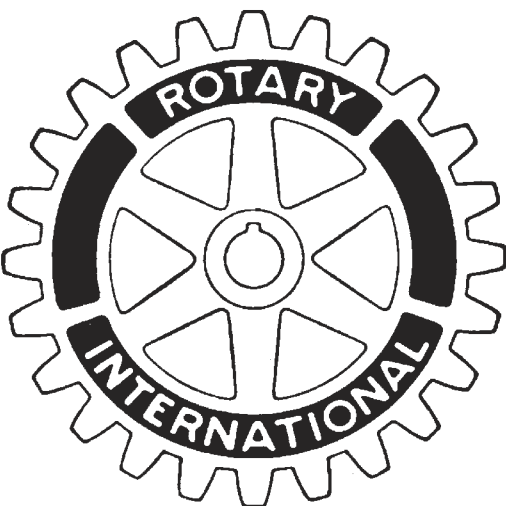

**“Biomass: Green and Sustainable Energy for Kentucky”**

Tom Kimmerer, PhD, is Senior Scientist with Moore Ventures LLC in Lexington Kentucky. Moore Ventures is an engineering firm involved in biomass power projects throughout the US. Tom is a forest scientist specializing in biomass planning, acquisition and logistics for power plants and liquid fuels production. Tom has a PhD in Forestry and Plant Physiology from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and a B.S. in forest biology from Syracuse. He was a Fulbright Scholar in Malaysia, and has been an advisor to the US Environmental Protection Agency, the USDA, the National Research Council and the government of Malaysia. Tom was a Professor of forestry, natural resources and plant physiology at the University of Kentucky for 18 years and has been a land management consultant for many years, including extensive experience in Malaysia and Indonesia.
