“Leadership for a Sustainable Future”

Jim Embry is director and founder of Sustainable Communities Network in Lexington. Since its founding in 2006 Jim has guided the development of over 30 community garden projects at homeless shelters, schools, empty lots, city parks, churches, domestic violence shelters, drug court programs, etc. He has organized four regional food conferences, and inspired community-wide art projects with Leadership Lexington. He serves on the board or as a member of many organizations that focus on sustainable living and social justice.

In 2009 more than 200 teachers from around Kentucky participated in school garden workshops that he organized and facilitated. Jim has given numerous presentations in diverse genres on sustainability and food systems, and is one of the authors of “Sustainable World Sourcebook” published this year. Often times called an “eco-activist” Jim was named Model of the Year by ACE Weekly in 2007, and is known for thinking “out-of-the-barn.”
