This Week's Speaker...

Jim Embry is the director and founder of Sustainable Communities Network in Lexington. He discussed community projects throughout this area including over 30 community garden projects at homeless shelters, schools, empty lots, city parks, churches, domestic violence shelters, etc.



Mr. Embry stated we are living in interesting times, and we must change our way of thinking about the earth.
