Nancy Baird, a native of Cincinnati (and the widow of a Bowling Green Rotarian who held a 46-year perfect attendance record!), earned an undergraduate degree from the University of Kentucky and Masters and Specialist degrees in history from Western Kentucky University. Since 1975 she has served on Western's faculty as the "history specialist" in the Kentucky Library. Fascinated by the commonwealth's past and by medical history, Baird has written numerous books and articles about the state's physicians and historic health problems, as well as about various other aspects about the commonwealth. Her most recent endeavor concerns the fascinating civil war diary of a Bowling Green lass. Her presentation is titled "Josie Underwood's Civil War Diary"

This Week's Speaker...

The speaker for the day was Stuart Sanders who is employed by the Kentucky Historical Society and is former executive director of the Perryville Battlefield Preservation Association. His organization is charged with preserving and interpreting Kentucky largest Civil War battleground. He stated that the Battle of Perryville occurred on October 8, 1862, which was intended by the South to hold Kentucky for the Confederacy. 7,500 were either killed

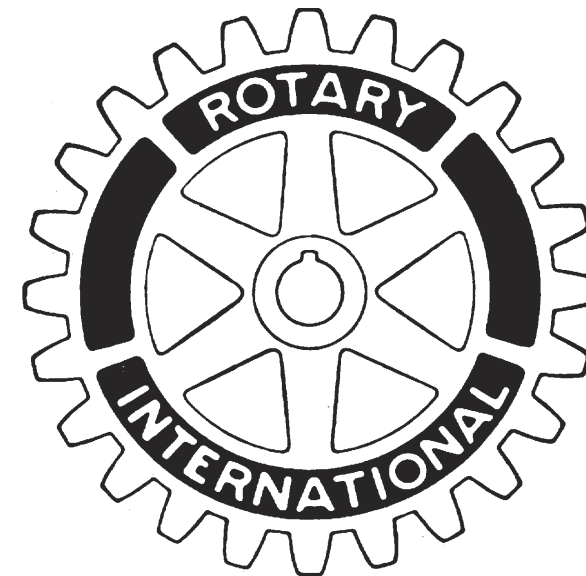

or wounded, and it was one of the most intense battles of the Civil War. While the Confederacy won a tactical victory, many of the Union troops did not engage in the battle. The Southern forces left Kentucky, never to participate in another major engagement in Kentucky. The battle did not have the intended effect – to cause large numbers of Kentuckians to enlist on the side of the Confederacy – and thus the South failed to hold both Maryland and Kentucky. 300 inhabitants of Perryville were left to care for the thousands of wounded soldiers and all houses; barns and stables in the area were turned into field hospitals. The economic losses to the area were immense, and many families were permanently displaced. The nearby town of Danville was also hit hard with many of the residents, in addition to the soldiers, dying from typhoid.
