**This Week's Speaker...**

The speakers for the day were Franklin County Judge/Executive Ted Collins, Blanton Coates, project superintendent for the new Judicial Center and Rick Cramer, architect for the project. Judge Collins stated that the Administrative Office of the Courts had an original list of a few courthouses, which needed to be replaced for reasons of security, and space needs. In order to build a new judicial center, the fiscal court needed to find an architect, bond counsel, construction manager and site selection committee, which held public hearings. The 1835 courthouse has been preserved as well as the Catholic Church. The old courthouse is flanked by the new additions. The architect, Rick Cramer gave a bit of the history of Frankfort and how in his design he was attempting to capture the pioneering spirit of the past to be integrated with the needs of the future. There are some 17 different architectural styles in Frankfort with about as many potential styles for the new building as he attempted to respect the past as we look to the future. The original courthouse was designed by Gideon Shyrook in the Greek Revival. Many different styles, designs and

Churchill who stated our environment shapes our public buildings but the architecture shapes our behaviors. The building will use geothermal energy. Codell Construction is in charge. Projects Superintendent Blanton Coates stated that there were imperfections in the brick veneer of the old courthouse but the bricks had been carefully replaced and much of the damage to the old courthouse had been done by previous constructions. The new building will be a blend of history and new technology. When completed, the total square footage will be 95,000 square feet. We are presently moving from the demolition to the construction phase. Bids will be let in December with construction actually beginning in January of 2011.
