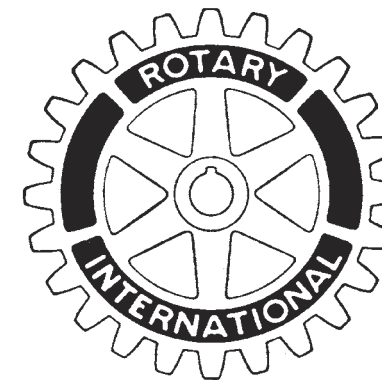
Family Court
