

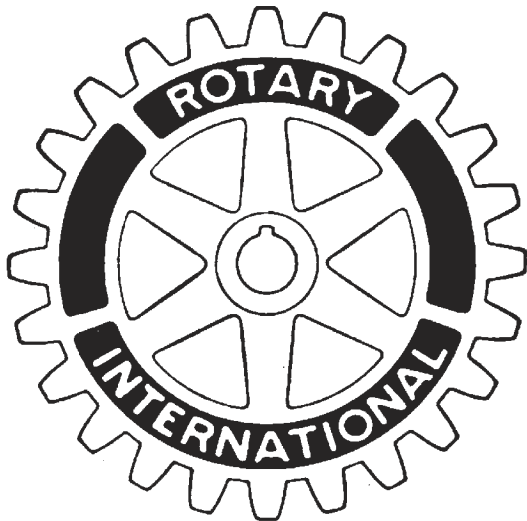

The speaker for the day was Transylvania President Owen Williams. He stated that there are three myths about higher education. The first is that the cost of college is going up. In actuality, costs have been going down the last two years and the difference is made up by the federal government pouring more money into higher education's as well as the financial

aid, which is available. A second myth is that the staff and faculty are overpaid. In fact they work for low wages and work for reasons other than the pay. The third myth is that the price of college is the same as the cost of college. Just like the sticker price on a car does not reflect what you actually pay, the two are not the same. Demand is going up faster than the supply. Also there are many foreign students in our colleges and universities. Colleges hire adjunct professors who make less than tenured professors. Costs vary with the amount of financial aid available. We often make the mistake of assuming that value is based on price when it comes to higher education. Just because a student does not go to an expensive school does not mean he or she is not getting a quality education.
