**Rick Sparks** is the Franklin County Attorney and has been in office since 2005. A 1984 Whitesburg High School graduate, Rick earned his bachelor's degree from UK in 1989. He moved to his new hometown of Frankfort and worked for the Cabinet for Health and Family Services, investigating child and family violence cases. In 1995, he earned his Juris Doctor from UofL and was admitted to the Kentucky Bar. He has practiced in the county attorney's office ever since. Rick is a member and past-president of the Franklin County Bar Association. He is a member of the Board of Directors of the Sunshine Center and the Ky. Agency for Substance Abuse Policy (Ky-ASAP). He assisted in the creation of Franklin County Family Court and its rules. As County Attorney, Rick represents the state and county in district and circuit courts and gives counsel to the fiscal court and county constitutional officers. He prosecutes misdemeanors and traffic offenses in Franklin district court. His office also manages the Franklin County child support collection and paternity program. Rick and his wife Jettie have two children: Morgan, age 12 and Marley, age 8 and live near the Kentucky River in northern Franklin County.
