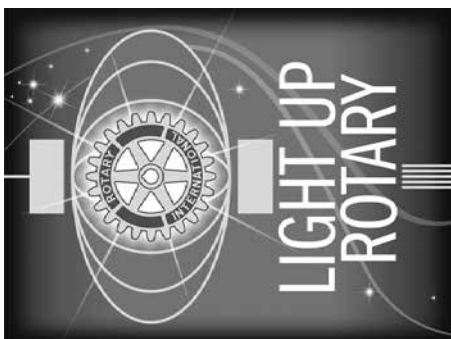

After 40 years as a radio announcer (37 of those in Frankfort) **Russ Hatter** quit the radio business in November 2001 to begin a new career as assistant curator of historic sites for the Frankfort Parks and Recreation Department.

Russ was born in Cincinnati, educated at Kentucky Christian College in Grayson and Kentucky State University. Hatter combined his love for theatre and history in creating the downtown Frankfort walking tour in 1992. He has been involved with the Frankfort Heritage Press and has published several local historical books including the most recent release "Frankfort Cemetery - The Westminster Abbey of Kentucky."

Besides 40 years of radio Hatter has had local television experience, appeared in two movies, contributed a local bi-weekly history column for over two years in the Frankfort State Journal, and directed and acted in numer-

ous theatre productions since 1958. He has narrated historical short films, documentaries, and acted in several television commercials.

Hatter has ten grandchildren: Zachary Paul, Michael Bryant, Ryan and Kyle Robinson, Reanna Marie, Jonathan Braeden Hatter, Kane Hatter, Finley Clifford Paul, Kimmel Aldridge Paul and Amani Robin Jean Davis. He and his wife Karen Kimmel have lived on Fourth Street in South Frankfort since 1987.
