THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Rotary's guest speaker was David Holwerk, editorial page editor of THE LEXINGTON HERALD-LEADER. Holwerk also serves as political commentator on KET's "Comment on Kentucky."

Holwerk discussed the primary election season, calling it one of the most difficult times for newspapers, especially editorial page editors. The LEXINGTON-HERALD has just completed their candidate interviews, and Holwerk had humorous assessments of the gubernatorial candidates during those interviews.

He said that some positives have resulted from this primary. Most important is the existence of an active Republican primary which, "assures that the next governor will be elected by a majority." Holwerk said that in the last general election, due to the absence of a Republican primary, only 12 percent of the state's total voters went to the polls.

He also complimented the candidates on their drive for ethics in government, and blamed low voter turnout on negative claims in television ads that are controlled by media consultants.

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Ted Bassett was our speaker May 15, 1991. He is a fellow Lexington Rotarian, a former Chief of State Police and the current President of the Breeder's Cup.

Mr. Bassett told us of his experience as Chief of Police during the 1967 Kentucky Derby. In 1967, race riots and freedom demonstrations were commonplace. The Derby would have been a perfect target for those wanting to make a statement to the world. Mr. Bassett took enormous precautions so that there would be a peaceful Derby. In the early morning hours before the Derby, he learned of a plan that involved the use of dog whistles by demonstrators near the starting gate. You can guess what the outcome would have been. Needless to say, divine intervention prevailed, there were no interruptions and a successful Derby was run.

This eighth running of the Breeder's Cup will be November 2nd at Churchill Downs in Louisville, In order to have a fold in the race, breeders must pay an entry fee of \$500.00. The NBC network will televise the race live across the nation and in 22 foreign countries. (NBC renewed the contract to televise the Breeder's Cup until 1995) Currently, work is being done to have the race simulcast to 91 U. S. racetracks and 20 overseas racetracks.

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Richard Luellan is president of Ashland Oil which believes in Education Advocacy thru corporate contributions. Ashland's SuperAmerica is headquartered in Lexington. Ashland also owns Valvoline and Ashland Service Corporation, with 1000 employees in Lexington. There are 25 SuperAmerica Service Stations and 6 Instant Oil Change Stops. Ashland was founded in 1918 and in 1936 it was headquartered in Ashland. Ashland Oil started out primarily in the areas of Refining, Transporting and Marketing. In the 1960's Ashland got involved with coal, highway paving and producing Natural Gas. With the Persian Gulf Crisis the U.S. developed a Natural Energy Strategy. Using free market principal the aim is to lessen dependence on foreign oil and improve environmental qualities. One proposal is a \$10 per barrel import fee on imported oil. This would generate 30 billion dollars a year. This would translate to a .23¢ a gallon of gasoline at the pump; However this proposal would add enormous cost to business. Alternative fuels are more expensive and cause other environmental problems. We need to conserve oil for transportation fuel. Mr. Luellan concluded his talk by stating we need to have economic education and to inform the public how corporations work.
