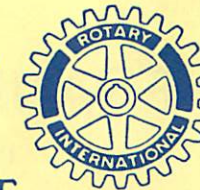

## THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Dr. John Hunt spoke about three phases of the interfaces between Science and Religion. 1.) For 1400 years the church had science under it's thumb. In the first century A.D. Ptolemy portrayed the universe as geocentric—the earth was the center of the universe. 2.) In 1400 there was the first real update by Copernicus the sun was the center of the universe. This was a heliocentric. Later updates were by Galileo who introduced the refracting telescope. Later Newton came upon the scene and the grip of the Church on science was slipping. This new mechanistic science didn't need God. 3.) Einstein's views were different from the classic psychology of Newton. Scientist came up with the Indeterminant Universe, which was a universe of probability and specifics measurable events and additions. Now we have a coming together between Scientist and Theologians. We didn't need to compartmentalize as Einstein said "Science without Religion is lame and Religion without science is blind."
