THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Gerald Pierce was the speaker today. He is Executive Director of the Center of Excellance for Quality at KSU. The Center promotes the production of Goods and Service that meet with total customer satisfaction. In manufacturing we have made the greatest gains in quality because of competition from abroad. In 1987 President Reagan created the Malcomb Baldridge National Quality Award. Companies considered it the most prestiges award. However, there are problems with the award from companies provided service.

It is difficult to define the quality of Service. There are a positive trends in the Service Industries: (a.) Banks are deeply involved in quality like the Farmers Bank, (b.) Health Companies are involved in offering patients better service. (c.) Education - there are not many states moving as fast as KY. The major concern is the emphasis on short term profits and instant gratification Today we are suffering from an excess from the 80's. Any one can increase profits with creative bookeeping but this doesn't improve quality. We need to take a long term outlook. Have we improved the business to compete better in the future? We shouldn't ask merely if profit this year is better than last years profits. The center of Excellance for Quality has created the Kentucky Quality Award.



THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Joseph Leary was the speaker for today's Rotary program. He spoke about Taxes. Under the Kentucky Constitution the General Assembly has the power to classify property but rates within the class must be uniform. Property shall not be assessed intentionally at a higher or lower relative value than the property of another. The value of Real Estate in Franklin County has declined 17 percent. Farm property must be assessed as farm property. Under the courts decision it is unconstitutional under both State and Federal Constitution to assess One part of the City at one time and the other part at a later date. Franklin County has four assessment areas which Mr. Leary says are unconstitutional. He stated that people are to apathetic about tax increases and are to eager to pay and let it go at that. People aren't exercising their constitutional right. Mr. Leary closed his talk by stating you may loss but you loss in a noble call.



THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Dr. Ted Kochar spoke about Genetic Engineering. DNA can be cut from different species and reinstated into organisms. Genetic Engineering came out of experiments on bacteria. Bacteria has one molecule of DNA. One can cut and splice enzymes. In the 60's & 70's we learned to page the genes. Enzymes can cut and splice DNA. The University has a DNA liberary which has a collection of DNA fragments. We clone DNA and make copies of the originals. Hormones can be produced by Genetic Engineering as follows: 1.) Insulin can be produced in mass.

- 2.) Groweth hormones produced.
- 3.) TPA produced to dissolve blood clots and for heart attact victims.
- 4.) More milk produced by cows.

DNA probes are used in Crime Labs. Vaccines can be made pure and safe for experimental Hapititis B. Transgenic plants and animals have been produced. Furthermore gene therapy in humans is possible.





