THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Phyllis Alexander was our speaker. She is Executive Director of the Kentucky Commission on Women based in Frankfort. She is married with two children, a native of Hazard, graduated from Western Kentucky University and resides in Lexington.

The Kentucky Commission on Women (KCW) focuses on issues affecting women in the Commonwealth. KCW was organized by Executive Order in 1964. KCW was approved officially and granted statutory status by 1970 General Assembly.

The Commission consist of twenty-Four members. A chairperson appointed by the Governor and Lt. Governor. The chairperson serves in a ex-officio capacity. The Executive Director and a staff of three people maintain the Commission office. The Commission's mission is to insure and promote the Hunan Rights of women throughout the state. This is accomplished by promoting favorable legislation and taking an active role in other areas such as Education and Public Information. KCW sponsors workshops, promotes research on various issues facing women and publishes a newsletter.

Phyllis concluded by emphasising that the Commission was very much involved in promoting spouse abuse programs throughout the state. We would like to thank Richard Taylor for today's Rotary program.

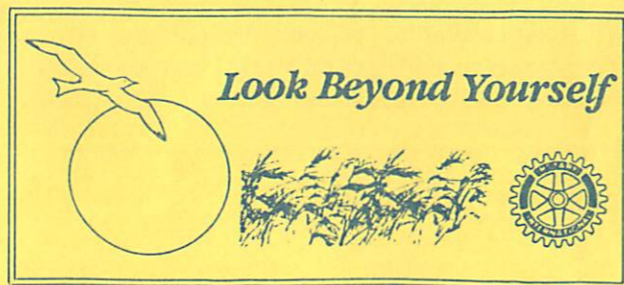

Kathy Noel, Executive Director of Downtown Frankfort, Inc.(DFI) presented the mission and goals of DFI and encouraged our personal and collective support.

In the 1970's, Main Street Programs were begun in the United States to encourage the preservation of historic and architecturally significant buildings in downtown areas. In 1989, DFI became 1 of 28 Main Street Programs in Kentucky.

DFI's strategy for success is four-fold: organize (involve all segments of the Community), promote (events in and for downtown), design (physical appearance and the physical needs of downtown), and economic restructuring.

Kathy stressed that while Downtown Frankfort may not be the retail center, it is the community center - the "heart of the community."

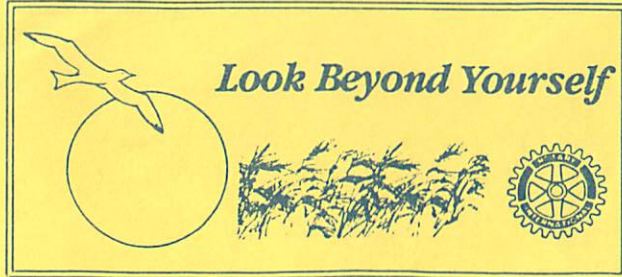

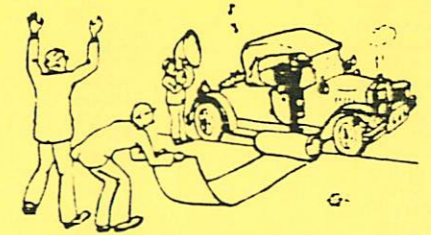

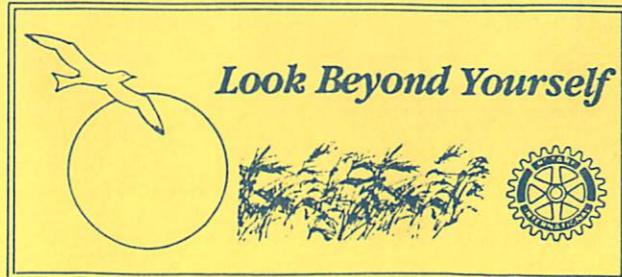

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Our speaker was Ken Miller, President of the Franklin County United Way. He spoke on the three areas of United Way, including how to : 1.) Motivate people to become volunteers in groups that work on behalf of other Franklin Countians. 2.) Be successful in raising funds in the United Way Campaign. United Way serves 24 agencies, 26 programs and the 1991 goal is to raise 665,000 dollars. At this time we are running a head of last year. 3.) Assess Community Needs. A community assessment committee including different segments of the community meet to determine the unmet needs of the community. Six areas of unmet needs were identified and termed Constellations. These were prioritized as follows: 1.) Needs of family and youth which includes household violence and teenage pregnancy. 2.) The need for more information about available services which includes Social Services Directories and better coordination among agencies. 3.) Self-sufficient needs which includes unemployment and homelessness. 4.) Recreation and cultural needs. Two-Thirds of the youth can't afford recreation. There is a need to reduce community apathy. 5.) Address substances abuse problems. 6.) The need to address community disunity and apathy.

The United Way will consider these constellations in funding groups and agencies in the future. Franklin County's per Capita contributes to United Way are above the national average. **NEXT WEEK'S PROGRAM**
