THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

District Governor Guy Hisle spoke about the unparalleled growth in Rotary today. There are 700 to 900 clubs added each year. New clubs have been established in the Old East Germany, Hungary, Poland and seven clubs in the U.S.S.R. Rotary International now has 1,200,000 members. Internationally, there are 27,000 clubs in 172 Countries. There will be 1.5 million members by the end of the century. Eighteen new District clubs are being added each year. There are 57 Rotary clubs in the Western Kentucky District; however, 22 counties have no clubs. Our district is working to create interest in these areas. The goal of Rotary is to overcome hunger and poverty. This is done directly by Rotary which bypasses Red Tape.

Two hundred and Thirty Million dollars have been raised for PolioPlus. By the year 2000 it is hoped that Polio will disappear from the world. The aim of Rotary is to let the caring person within each of us to come out. We must see all the needs around us which must be met. We need to develop an inner strength and a world free of want, illiteracy and prejudice. We need to translate this vision into acts. Look beyond yourself and make this the "Our Generation" instead of the "Me Generation." District Governor Guy concluded his talk by stating we may never know when we have touched the life of someone else.

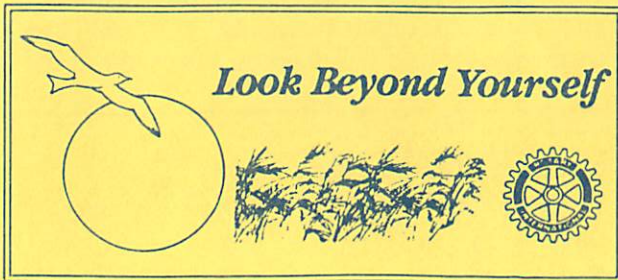

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Franklin County Attorney Jim Boyd discussed the recent purchase of the Carter Farm on Georgetown Road as the site of the proposed Franklin County Park and Community Center.

Jim said that the property, adjacent to the Franklin County High School, is large enough to accommodate an indoor horse show arena and stables, tennis, volleyball and basketball courts, softball and soccer fields, a par 3 golf course and clubhouse, and playgrounds and picnic areas.

Jim also announced that, adjacent to the proposed community center in the office complex, the Franklin County Extension Agency will be the first organization to build offices in that complex.

Fiscal Court is working in a dual relationship with the school board in order to make this proposal a reality. Sources of funding are being explored since county finances are not able to begin construction of the community center.

Jim called the proposed park an "Assit to the community and will benefit all Franklin Countians."

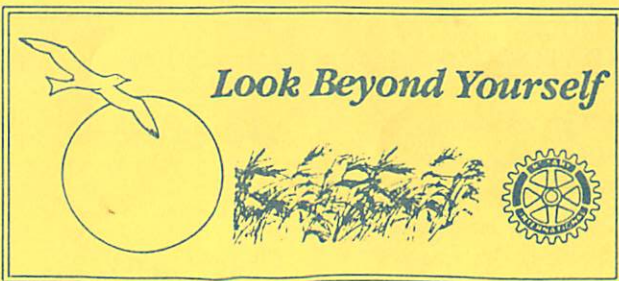

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Bob Babbage was this week's speaker. Mr. Babbage stated that when he took office Audits were 18 months to 10 years behind. Half of his staff are in Frankfort and the other half are located across the state. Mr. Babbage supports the Maloney Bill which provides for elections in even number years, lowers campaign spending limits and provides for public financing of campaigns. In 1988 he adopted a code of ethics in his office. He spoke of the need to get the 800,000 non-registered persons into the process. We need an election channel on cable which would provide candidate interviews and profiles and experts on the issues. Mr. Babbage also stated there is a need in Kentucky for an incentive system and regional cooperation. There are a 120 counties in Kentucky and 1,500 special districts. There is a need for privatizing parts of government and securing partnerships between the public and private sector. We also need a local leadership program to identify, recognize and reward leaders.

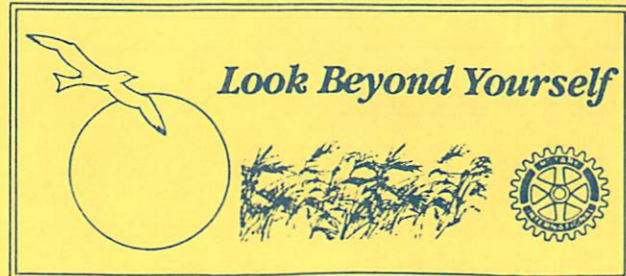

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

The speaker today was John Stempel, former Career Diplomat. He stated that we are passing through a major shift in world politics including: 1.) Technology breakthroughs - We are now in a world market. 2.) Authority crisis - We are moving into a era of human and civil rights there is a break down in politic consensus. 3.) Decentraliation-states and cities now have offices abroad. In the USSR we are seeing a total economic collapse. We are witnessing the only break up in history not triggered by Civil War or External Warfare. There is increasing nationalizm in the USSR. If the Soviet Army collapses nuclear weapons could end up in the hands of the Republics. Human rights violations are still taking place. Massive reconstruction and assistance to the USSR is needed. Foreign relations will be more complex today. We are cooperating with the USSR on the Middle East. Mr. Stempel stated there are two reasons that we didn't oust Saddam Hussein. It wasn't in the UN mandate and it would make the U.S. responsible for problems in the Middle East. There are three objectives in the Mid-East Peace Conference: 1.) Keep balance in the region, 2.) Bring other people into the region and involve others in the resolution of problems, We need to get people to compromise on issues and bring pressures on friends and enemies alike, and 3.) We need to have patients and take the long term views.

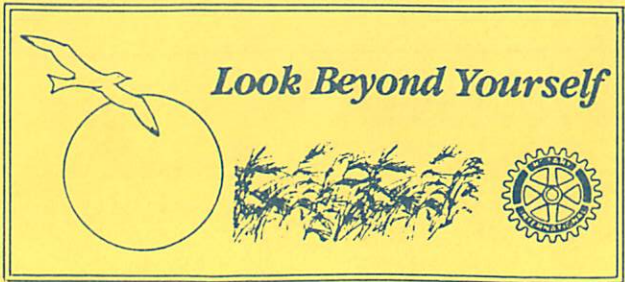

Bremer Erhler, Secretary of State was our speaker today. The Secretary of State's office serves: 1.) Corporations, 2.) Land Offices, 3.) Seal of Commonwealth, 4.) Kentucky Colonel Commissions and 5.) Notary Commissions. The Secretary of State is the chairman of the State Board of Elections. At the present there is 1,891,962 registered voters in the State. Candidacy papers and election returns are filed with the Secretary of State. There are various reasons why Kentucky voters have lost interest and thus created low voter turn-out: 1.) constant elections, 2.) costs, 3.) negative programming and 4.) inaccessible polling places. In 1990, 14% of the polling places were inaccessible. Mr. Erhler does not think the Secretary of State should be appointed. In the May Primary, age groups voted as follows:

17 to 24	19%
25 to 34	25%
35 to 49	37%
50 to 61	45%
over 62	46%

Voter percentages were better in Franklin County.

17 to 24	38%
25 to 34	53%
35 to 49	71%
50 to 61	77%
over 62	71%

There are 94,000 more registered females than males in Kentucky.

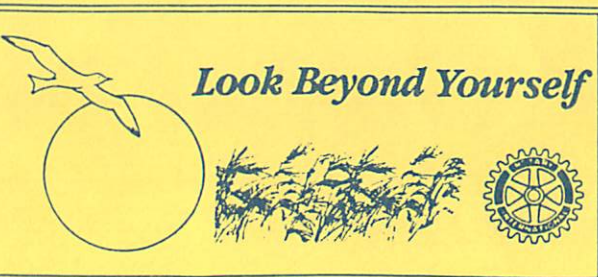
