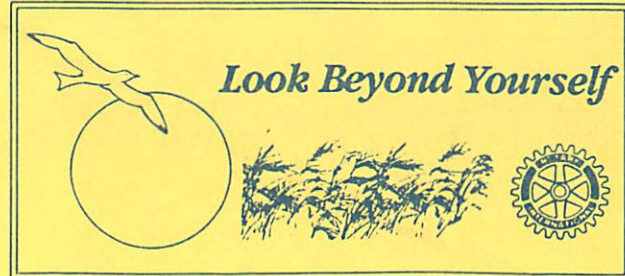

## THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Jeanne Suchanek spoke about the Kentucky History Center. Jeanne stated that we can't plan for today unless we consider what came before us. The legislative Mandate of the Kentucky Historical Society (KHS) is to collect, preserve and interpret the past. We can't escape our history.

KHS has visual treats

For many students the center will be the most important place to visit in Frankfort. One-third of the visitors to KHS are from out of state. For 150 years the KHS has been the states guardian of the past. The KHS is bursting at its seams. There is a need for additional room for artifacts. The Kentucky History Center will be 170,000 sq. feet. In 1990, the Legislators appropriated 2 million dollars for design and site acquisition. The center will be bordered by Broadway & Clinton & High streets. It will consist of a 350 seat auditorium, exhibit gallery, education classrooms, collect storage, a conservation laboratory and a research library.

The goals for the Kentucky History Center are: 1.) Tourism Revenue, 2.) Safe environment for collection, 3.) Room for artifacts and 4.) Education

Other states have similar centers. The quality of life will be improved in Frankfort. The cost of the building will be 15.5 million dollars. Jeanne concluded her talk by saying we are preserving the past and moving to preserve the future.

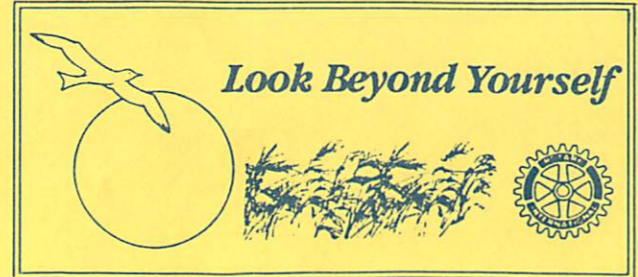

**THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM**

Dr. Howard Ross, Vice President for Academic Affairs and University Provost at Kentucky State University spoke to Rotary about his philosophy of higher education.

Dr. Ross noted that higher education had to meet the requirements of an industrial age. Now, however, higher education must meet the requirements for an information age where information processing is key. Even the concept of a classroom has changed. The instructor need not be physically present to teach, as in the case of televised classrooms.

Higher education now has to deal with a shrinking economy, and must be more accountable to the public for its expenditures. Higher education must also demonstrate the graduating students are ready to work in the information age.

Dr. Ross said that everything about the university exists to serve the learning process and everything else at the university is superfluous.

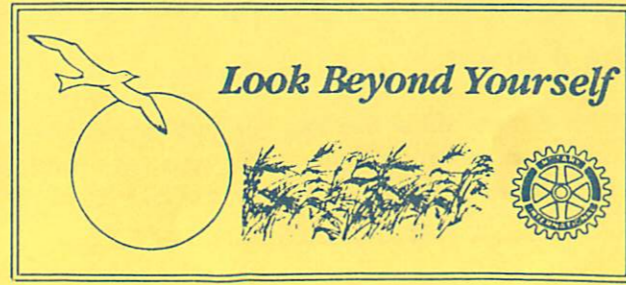

When a man becomes a Rotarian he assumes certain obligations. One of these is attendance. A member who does not attend is not participating fully in the life and spirit of Rotary.

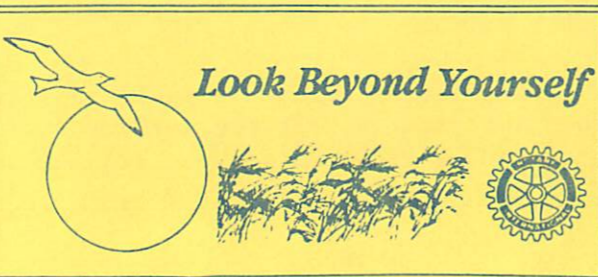
