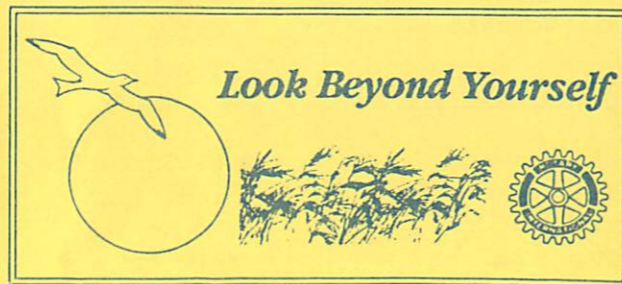

Henry "Hank" Graddy, a lawyer for environmental issues spoke to Rotary. Mr. Graddy is a strong advocate for environmental protection and refers to himself as an activist. He is involved in such issues as the Lake Cumberland Trust, the Louisville Airport expansion, community landfills and the urban services area in his home county of Woodford.

Mr. Graddy not only quoted from several Kentucky statutes and the Clean Water Act but used many Biblical quotes to support his beliefs that we are the caretakers of the earth. As Caretakers we should reach for the highest standards of environmental protection rather than the minimum.

Mr. Graddy favors the adoption of a Kentucky Green Policy, making Kentucky the most environmentally responsible state in the nation.

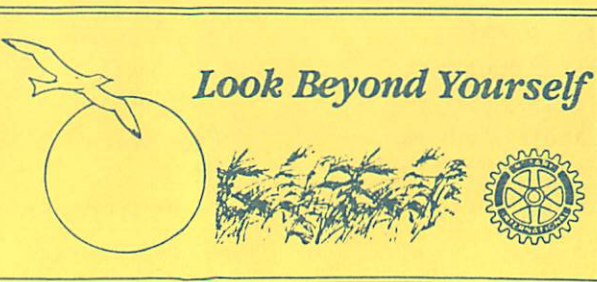
