THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Bill Straub of the Kentucky Post compared management skills of Governor Wilkinson and Governor Jones. He called Wilkinson the Last of the Jacksonian Democrats. President Jackson, like Wilkinson, came from outside the main stream and identified himself with the Spoils System. Both Governor Wilkinson and President Jackson fought with the legislation branch. President Jackson was censured by the U. S. Senate over executive powers. Both Jackson and Wilkinson had a temper. Jones may be the Great Compromizer like Henry Clay Wilkinson, who did everything himself. While Jones is more likely to listen to other people. The 400 million dollar budget short fall is not really Wilkinson's fault, as the recession caused it. Jones is trying to be all things to all people. As to the 1992 General Assembly it's off to an inauspicious start. Fewer bills have been filed because there is no money to spend on new programs. Jones is pushing succession (not including himself) and wants to merge several constitutional offices. On other topics, Bill is opposed to term limits on the Federal and State levels. He stated that Superintendent of Education Stephen's is a good lawsuit but was brought up for all the wrong reasons. He also predicted that Mario Cuomo may come into the Presidential race if Clinton fades.

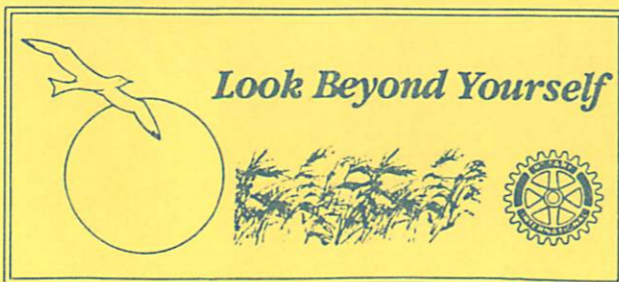

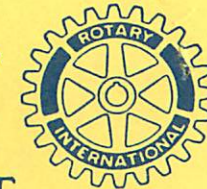

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Mayor Houston "Ticker" Wells spoke at our February 12th meeting.

Mayor Wells updated members on successful recycling projects in seven neighborhoods. Now all residents of Frankfort are participating. In six weeks, 150,000 lbs. of recycled material was collected and revenues of \$6,000 added to the city coffers.

The proposed South Frankfort Flood Wall will begin construction in July 1993. The flood wall (\$13 million project) will be funded by city, state and federal governments. The wall promises to be esthetically pleasing to the eye and will only displace 20-26 homes. Construction should take three years to complete.

The Sullivan Square Parking Garage, (\$7 million project) will provide downtown businesses and patrons with a 524 space parking garage and 42,000 square feet of office space. Completion is targeted for July 1992.

The State Crime Laboratory (adjacent to the East/West Connector) will be a state-of-the-art facility which will employ over 300 people.

The Kentucky River Park, (still in the development stages) will offer camping, fishing, canoeing, volleyball and other facilities. Local residents will be able to enjoy the river and activities related to river life.

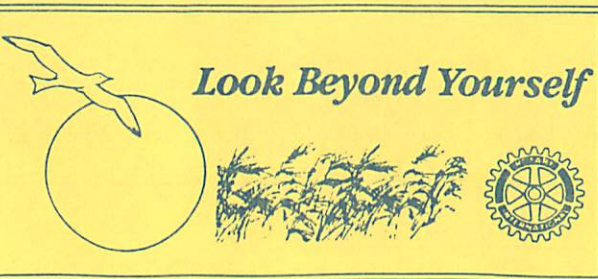

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Governor Brereton Jones' campaign manager, Steve Miller, was our guest speaker. Steve, now in private law practice, also works as a consultant to Gov. Bill Clinton's presidential campaign.

Miller was both entertaining and informative in his discussion of local and national politics. Miller said five valuable lessons were learned from the 1991 gubernatorial race: (1) the candidate who enters the race the earliest and works the hardest usually wins; (2) The regional candidates usually do not win; (3) The issues do matter; (4) a strong field organization is vital; (5) there are new game rules for the media, especially concerning how to handle negative ads.

On the national level, Miller predicted President Bush will be the republican nominee but Pat Buchanan's 40% showing in the New Hampshire primary indicated that Bush is "damaged goods". He also predicted that Bill Clinton will be the Democratic nominee on the first ballot and that the general election will be extremely close. "This is the year that Washington insiders will have difficulty in maintaining the White House," he said.

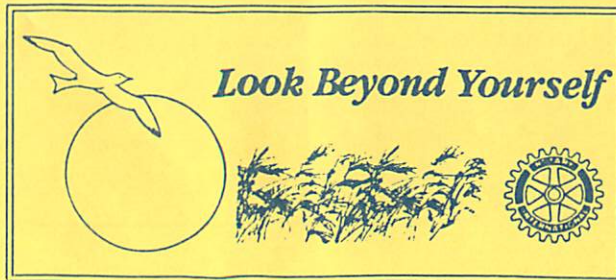

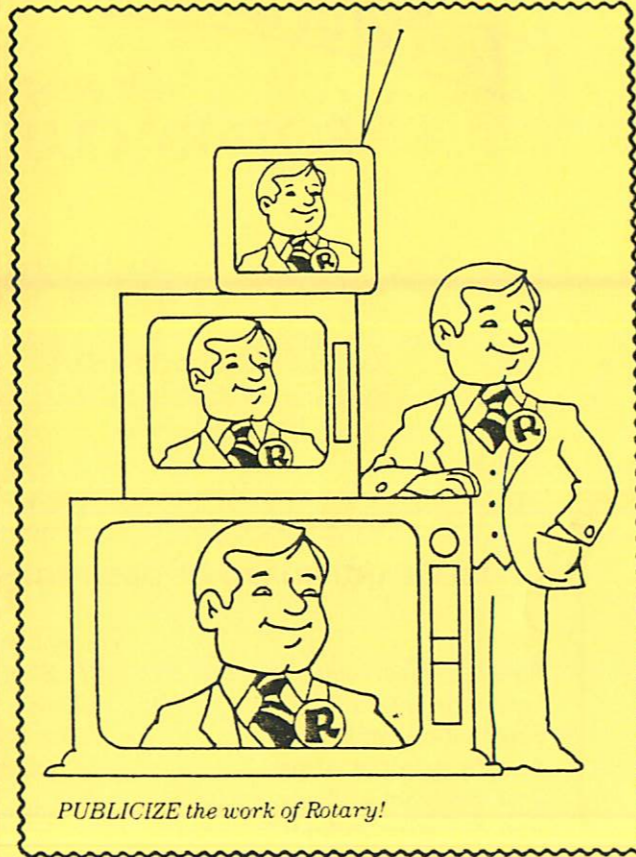

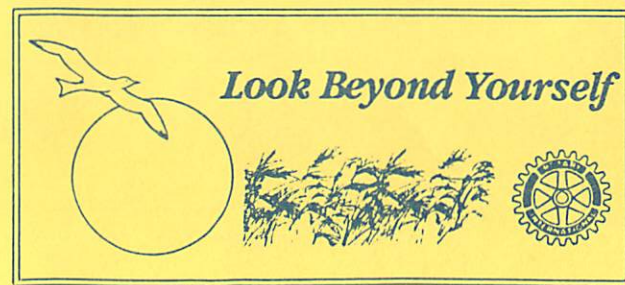
