THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Paul Rice, Franklin County School Superintendent, was out speaker. Paul conveyed a Ford Motor official's philosophy that "if its not broke make it better". Twenty to Twenty-Five percent of our students are drop outs and the jobs they traditional took are disappearing. Our economy can't afford anymore throw away students.

We need to look at the integration of curriculum. We need to change the role of the teacher and facilitate classes differently. For example can be taught in conjunction with humanities. The "Number Theory" and Shakespear can be intergrated. Music is based on math.

We need ongoing training, apprenticeships and partnerships. For example the Germans don't stop school at the 12th grade. We must become life long learners. We need apprenticeships at the high school and post high school levels. It isn't necessary to go to college to be successful. Many college graduates can't get jobs in their respected fields.

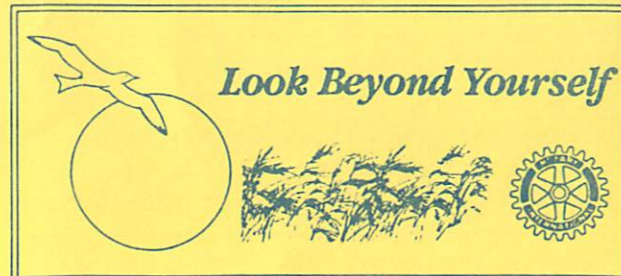
