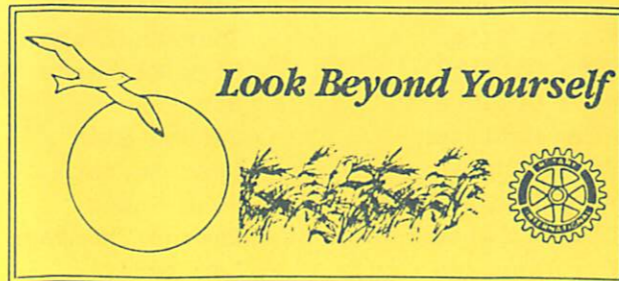

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Rick Jones spoke to the Rotary Club today on guns. Guns and ammunition bring in about 6.5 billion dollars in revenue in the USA a year. Two and half million of the excise tax goes to wildlife management. There are 340 thousand hunters in Kentucky and 14.5 million in America. There are 6.5 million shooters who don't hunt with several ranked shooters in Frankfort. The Murray State University is ranked nationally. Rick expertise is in long range black powder cartridge shooting. He uses old fashion guns which are extremely accurate and shot at targets 200 to a 1000 yards away. He demonstrated Sharp's Rifle which was to hunt Buffalo in the old west. It weighs 12 1/2 lbs. A re-creation of the Sharp Buffalo rifle cost \$16,000. There is a business for rifle re-creations. Rick cast his own bullets and does his own loads to save on expenses. He must use a recoil pad because of the kick from the rifle.

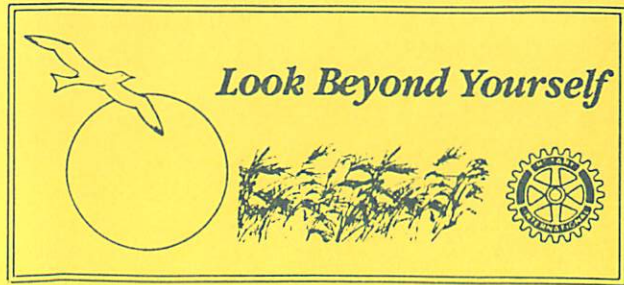

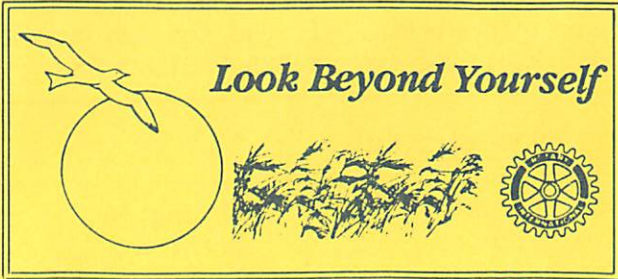

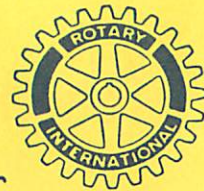

Prentice Harvey was the speaker for Rotary today. He is a lawyer for the State Farm Insurance. State Farm is a Mutual Company owned by the policy holders. Its goal is to provide high security at the lowest rate. If premiums are too high the dividends are paid back to policy holders or rates are lowered. An adage in the insurance business is that claims drive cost. The rates are calculated according to the size and number of claims. In Kentucky, liability cost have increased by 195% over the last decade. Bodily injuries claims have grown by 53%. As a result, many citizens have been priced out of the insurance market. Stacking policies increases cost. State Farm supports the seat belt bill and supports all traffic safety measures. The recent sex discrimination lawsuit settlement will not increase premiums because safety reserves had been set aside earlier to cover the lawsuit's settlement.

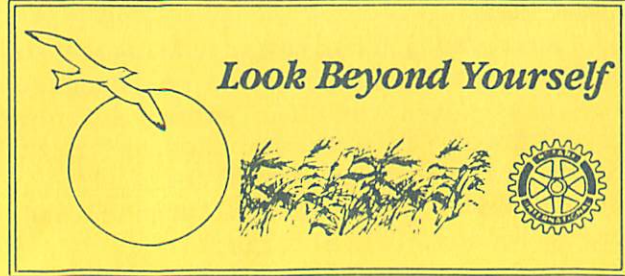
