Carl Fudge, Jr. spoke about Harpsichords and clavichords. He has built over 100 custom instruments and does restorations. He has restored one of the oldest organs in the country. He has lectured in the U.S., European and Mexican Universities. His slide presentation showed clavichords, including one Italian instrument (1978), a German (1928), a French (1786) and a Flemish instrument. After the slide show he played a Flemish Harpsichord which is in a rectangular box. He also played the clavichord. The clavichord surfaced in Europe and Germany as a practice instrument for organist.

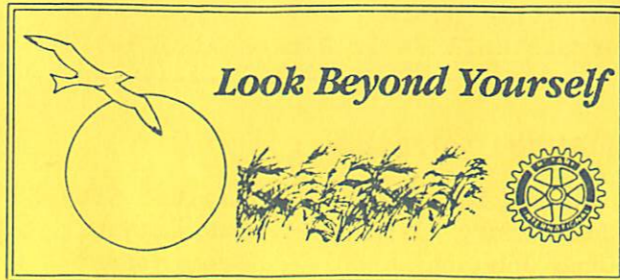

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Barbara Jones, General Counsel for the Corrections Cabinet gave an insightful presentation on the status of female attorneys in public and private sectors, and an overview of the parole system in Kentucky.

Jones said that in 1970, three percent of the attorneys nationwide were female. In 1988, 20 percent of the attorneys were women. The law profession has opened itself in the past 20 years to more women; however, the glass ceiling still exists in the legal profession for women in the judiciary, in law firms and in government.

Jones said that government is attractive for both male and female attorneys because there is less change of discrimination and more opportunity for promotion for women. Attorneys learn a variety of issues at a quicker rate in government rather than in a law firm: General Counsels in government are comparable to the managing partner in major law firms. Jones also noted that government is more aware of family needs and concerns. She said that with more women in the practice of law as well as in the workplace, the workplace itself as well as professions have become more "human", realizing the importance of shared responsibilities and family life.

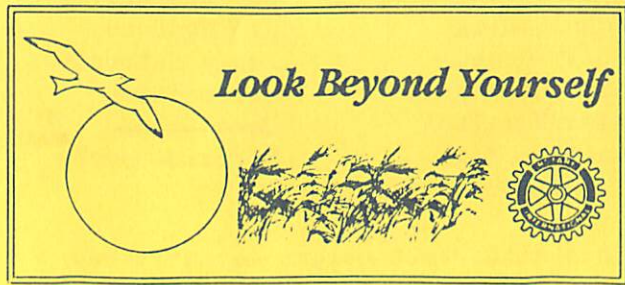

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Fellow Rotarian and historian Charlie Hinds presented a personal/historical profile on General Patton, one of the greatest tactical generals of all time.

Charlie is one of the very few survivors of Patton's division, and the only member of his platoon of a cavalry troop to make every one of the seven campaigns in World War II, (1941-45).

Patton was the creator of the tank forces as tactical units in two wars. He was given the task to experiment with the 2nd Armored Division (Hines' Division) in order to strengthen and make the units more effective.

Patton was a strict believer in discipline and aggression. His abilities were organizing, training and leading troops into battle. He was often flamboyant, theatrical, and outrageous distorter of the truth and rather foulmouthed.

To that end, he became terribly frustrated at his commanders for their lack of "storming" initiative. If it wasn't in the plan, it wasn't done. He did suffer from mental illness (delusions of grandeur perhaps) and he is best remembered by the movie of his name which depicted his life and career.
