**THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM**

Rotary's guest speaker was State Senator David Karem of Louisville. Senator Karem is Senate Majority Caucus Chairman, Chairman of the Legislative Ethics Committee and chairs the Kentucky Bicentennial Commission, and is a 21 year veteran of the state legislature.

Karem said that the committee is presently looking at law pertaining to ethics in the legislature and attempting to more clearly define and revise those laws.

Full disclosure of campaign contributions and campaign finance reform in terms of lowering the contribution limits are being researched as possible entrants into a legislative ethics package. The relationship of legislators to lobbyists is also being looked at for possible and probable restrictions. Karem does not believe that the "no cup of coffee" rule (a lobbyist cannot buy so much as a cup of coffee for a legislator) will be passed.

Our thanks to Senator Karem for a most informative, enlightening and at times, humorous presentation.

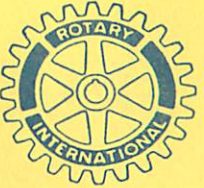

Steve Brooks, Director of the Frankfort Parks and Recreation Department, was the guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club for Wednesday, July 15, 1992.

Steve has been the Director of the Parks Department for 22 years. He was born, reared and educated in Frankfort. He is married to the former Patty Bennett and has two children.

Steve currently oversees a budget of \$1.7 million. There are 4 public parks, 2 public swimming pools and 11 baseball/softball fields. His philosophy is that if you put time and money into a parks/recreation system the rewards for the children/youth of the community will be in the future of the community. Along with fast-food restaurants, the Parks/Recreation Department is the largest employer of young people in Frankfort. Not to be remiss, Frankfort has a wonderful 18 hole golf course at Juniper Hills Park. Over 80,000 rounds of golf will be played during this year at Juniper Hills.

Future plans are underway for the development of additional baseball and soccer fields (Carter Farm). Frankfort will again be the host of the Girls State Basketball Tournament in March 1993. This tournament alone will bring in over \$5 million in tourism dollars to Frankfort.

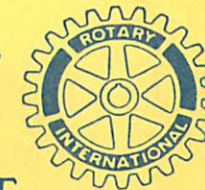

## THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Officer Steve Clark of the Frankfort Police Department spoke about the D.A.R.E. program. We are in a war against drugs but it is a winnable war. Education is the big weapon against drugs. School programs have been conducted in Frankfort for several years. D.A.R.E. speakers include Police Officers, Attorneys and Judges. In 1983 the D.A.R.E. program was started in Los Angeles by Chief Darryl Gates. D.A.R.E. is in all 50 states and 14 foreign countries. Over 4 million students have gone through it. The average drinking age for alcohol use is 14. It is 15 for marijuana. One in five users of drugs become sellers or dealers. Most have tried alcohol at home. "Huffing" of substances such as glue, paints, gasoline and magic markers is also a problem. There are three sides to combating drugs: 1.) Police, 2.) School systems and 3.) Parents. Topics of the D.A.R.E. program include consequences of drug use, resistance techniques, such as how to say no, self-esteem, managing stress without using drugs, media influence on drug use and decision making. The students in the program write a essay in class on staying off drugs. The students also form support groups.

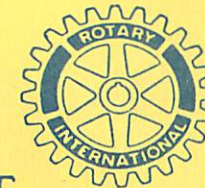
