THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Cindy Preszler from Channel 27 News was our speaker today. Cindy answered various questions about weather forecasting from members in the Audience. She said the Elnio and volcanic activity have made for a cool summer. However, because the Elnio is dving we may look forward to a more severe winter than last year. Cindy said that she exchanges information with the National Weather Service but the National Weather Service has old equipment and no satellite. Cindy by contrast has State-of-the-Art weather equipment. Her twelve to twenty-four hour forecast are 75 to 80 percent correct; however, the 90 day forecast is nothing but a educated guess and is based on trends.

The Ohio River effects our weather in Central Kentucky. Many weather fronts from Indiana dye out at the Ohio River or they follow the Ohio River up stream.



Charles Howell, fellow Rotarian and former Tennessee Commissioner of Conservation, was the guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club today.

Mr. Howell spoke very eloquently about Earth stewardship. As a former Commissioner of Conservation, he notes the following steps we all can undertake to ensure a "green" future for our Earth's inhabitants:

- 1. How we farm we need to improve the way we till the soil.
- 2. How we use chemicals in farming.
- 3. Attend to the needs of wetlands.

- 5. Use only environmentally safe products to build homes and businesses. The book How to Build Green is an excellent resource for this purpose.
- 6. Last but not least REDUCE, REUSE and RECYCLE!

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Dr. Meredith of Western Kentucky University has been President there for four years. He stated that higher education in Kentucky is good business. Universities are corporations. It is usually the largest employer in the area. Thirty thousand people are employed by Kentucky Institutions of Higher Learning. They have a annual operating budget of \$1.6 billion, \$1 million is in salaries. The Sate invests \$674 million to get a \$1.6 billion return. The state contributes 42 percent of the operating budget of Kentucky Public Universities. This represents a 138 percent return on investments. Grants for research projects amount to \$7.7 million at Western. There are 157 thousand students at Kentucky Universities. Sixty percent of whom are full-time. Four and a half percent of the total state population are taking courses at Institutions of Higher Education. This is a record. There has been a 40 percent increase in the last six years in student populations. Also non-academic courses are offered. Each student spends an average of \$500 a month not counting tuition. Every year 20,000 students gradute from Kentucky colleges. Only 1 in 11 Kentuckians have a college degree. In essence, the state gets an excellent return on its investment. \$58.6 million has been taken out of this year's state budgets for Higher Education.
