Jim Host who is President of Host Communications was today's speaker. He discussed Bill Curry as one of the finest individuals in any college football program. Curry will be U.K.'s coach for the rest of his career. U.K.'s first game with Central Michigan will determine if this Kentucky team will be 7-4 or 4-7. THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Abbie Robinson-Armstrong, Director of the Division of Early Childhood Education, Kentucky Department of Education, was the guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club for Wednesday, September 9, 1992.

Ms. Robinson-Armstrong brings 21 years of educational expertise to Kentucky to help implement the primary school program. The primary program is part of the elementary school in which children are enrolled from the time they begin school until they are ready to enter the fourth grade; an approach to failure-free schools mandated by the Kentucky Education Reform Act (KERA).

Senate Bill 420, passed this session, clarifies KERA Primary Program implementation timelines and focuses on the full involvement of children in a developmentally appropriate primary program. The legislation requires that the primary program be fully implemented by the start of the 1993-94 school year.

Full implementation means that all children in kindergarten through third grade classes will be participating in primary programs that demonstrate the following critical attributes:

- *developmentally appropriate practices
- *multi-age, multi-ability classrooms
- *authentic assessment
- *qualitative reporting methods
- *professional teamwork
- *positive parent involvement

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Fuzio Cho, President and Chief Executive Officer of Toyota Motor Manufacturing, Georgetown, Kentucky and fellow-Rotarian, was the guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club for Wednesday, September 16, 1992.

Mr. Cho is a graduate of the University of Tokyo with a degree in law. He and his wife reside in Georgetown and have two sons.

Toyota Motor Manufacturing (TMM) first began production in their Georgetown plant in July 1988. Since its inception over 750,000 Camrys have been produced. By July of 1993, one million Camrys will have rolled off the assembly lines.

Ninety-six percent of the employees at TMM are Kentuckians. One hundred and fifty-four Franklin County residents are employed at TMM. As in Rotary, perfect attendance and team work are the foundations which help make Toyota produce a world class automobile. Mr. Cho stressed that quality and customer satisfaction are the top priorities at TMM.

When asked why TMM chose to expand the Georgetown plant to produce V-6 engines and Automobile parts, Mr. Cho stated that "The Kentucky workforce has proven to be the best. Why change a good thing (and move somewhere else)?" The new facility will be completed in early 1994. It will be approximately 200 acres under roof and will house an employee child care center, fitness and additional team member service.

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Lynn Luellen, Executive Director of Kentucky Housing Corporation was today's speaker. KHC started out with an initial \$150,000 loan from the State of Kentucky which was re-paid. KHC makes funding available to lending institution for persons who don't otherwise qualify. It's triple "A" Bond rating is higher than the State's. There are 53 agencies throughout the country. KHC services the second lowest incomes & has a strong financial base. There are three programs for KHC:

- 1.) The Ownership Program makes available tax exempt mortgage revenue bonds. Thirty-Two thousand home loans have been made serving 80,000 people. In Franklin County KHC has 1,100 home loans for \$38.5 million dollars. The average purchase price is \$41,000, an average income is \$18,000. KHC loans are from 1% to 7% interest for 25 to 30 years. The program also covers down payments and or closing costs. Farmers Bank is the initial lender. "The Yes You Can" program helps people learn to become homeowners.
- 2.) The Rental Program finances apartments in 110 countries since 1977. This is a substance program which is designed to move people out of substance programs and into home ownership. Transitional housing tax credits are also available and utility security payments are guaranteed.





Crit Luallen, Secretary of the Tourism Cabinet was today's speaker. She stated that Tourism in the U.S. brings in \$44 billion in tax revenues. It is the leading export in these country with a \$107 billion trade surplus. In Kentucky, Tourism is the third largest Industry and second largest employer. It brings in \$373 million in tax revenues in Kentucky alone. Fifty million dollars is generated annually in Franklin County. Tourism has tremendous impact here. The trend today is for shorter and more frequent vacations one hundred miles or within a days drive of Kentucky. Frankfort's proximity to I-75 helps Tourism here in Frankfort. Older travelers wish to learn more about Kentucky's history and culture. The State Historical Council is involved. A Tourism Task Force has been organized to promote Kentucky's cultural heritage. State and Local cooperation is critical. The Tourism Cabinet can't operate in a vacuum an example is the Matching Fund Program. Unfortunately only \$1.6 million is spent in Kentucky for Tourism promotional advertising. A Bond issue has been proposed to renovate Kentucky's Parks. No place is more spectacular than Frankfort. Crit concluded by stating that in Kentucky we have unique natural resources and beauty. There is a indomitable spirit of people in Kentucky.
