#### THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

The speaker today was Maria Henson, an editorial writer for the Lexington Herald-Leader who won a Pulitzer prize for the investigative series of articles called "To Have and To Harm". There were 17,000 reports of spouse abuse in Kentucky last year which was a 33% increase over the previous year. A wife is nine times as likely to be the victim of domestic violence than on the streets. We need to treat domestic violence as a crime. The most dangerous time is when the wife tries to end a marriage or relationship. They do not leave their homes because they often have no place to go and there are few battered women's shelters. Although Kentucky enacted a domestic violence law in 1984, enforcement was often lax. It all depended on how seriously the police, prosecutors and judges regard wife beating. Many times victims do everything they can but no one takes them seriously. The series "To Have and to Harm" spotlighted this problem. There have been many tremendous successes after the series appeared. The Attorney General's Task Force on Domestic Violence was formed. The Kentucky Chief Justice ordered court files opened to show how prosecutors and judges are doing. With the help of the Attorney General, domestic violence laws were passed in 1992. Courts are now accessible 24 hours a day and stalking is now a crime. Clayton Bradley was singled out as being a private citizen who has made a big difference in the area of spouse abuse and was praised for her effortsNEXT WEEK'S PROGRAM





The Honorable Paul Patton, Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, was the guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club for Wednesday, December 16, 1992.

Lt. Governor Patton has the distinction of being the only lieutenant governor appointed Secretary of the Economic Development Cabinet while fulfilling his dutes as an elected official. Mr. Patton views his appointment by Governor Jones as a meaningful one which utilizes his knowledge and ideas to implement economic development in Kentucky.



#### THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

The speaker for today was Elizabeth Robertson, Executive Director of Big Brothers/Big Sisters. In March 1970, a caring group of people in Franklin County got together and identified some 400 Children in single parent families in need of role models and Big Brothers of Frankfort was formed. In 1972, Big Sisters was organized also. The criteria for a Big Brother or Big Sister is to be a resident of Franklin County for at least 6 months and be mature and responsible Big Brothers/Big Sisters are need for children age 6 and to 13. Once matched, a young person can stay with the program until age 18. The organization provides quality professional services to youth to achieve their highest potential. The child is not looking for a substitute parent but is looking for a friend and mentor. This person must challenge the child to be all he or she can be. What is needed here is that special match which will be a rewarding situation for everyone. These are young lifes you can touch in a personal way. Polly Green and Judge Reed Rhorer spoke of their personal experiences as a big brother and big sister. About 2 hours a week is recommended so that the program is not time consuming. To raise money for the program, there is a Bowl for Kids' Sake in which government and business teams are involved.
