**THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM**

Chief Justice Robert Stephens spoke about the relationship between the State Courts and Congress. In the last 15-20 years there has been a tremendous litigation explosion. In 1981, 100 million cases were filed in state courts. Kentucky has experienced a 4-7% increase a year since 1976. Every week the Kentucky Supreme Court has three and one half new cases which are "appeals of right". In the Court of Appeals, 13 new cases are assigned to each judge per month on which opinions must be written. The average work load for a circuit judge is 850-875 new cases each year. The complexity of cases has also increased. Furthermore, there are about 600-700 new attorneys each year in Kentucky. This has meant increase delay, an inferior work product coming from the courts, increased expenses to litigants and a lack of public confidence in the courts system. Also society is more hostile today. Congress has also made matters worse with public interest legislation which has put more of a burden on the courts. However, Congress is not concerned with the court's work load and provides no additional resources. Federal bureaucrats use a carrot and stick approach to make state legislatures enact certain legislation. These are federally imposed guidelines with no thought to the problems they cause for the courts. Congress remains unconcerned and isolated.

Pat Mulloy, Secretary of the Finance and Administration Cabinet spoke to Rotary. Since his appointment on November 1, 1992, Governor Jones has charged Secretary Mulloy with a variety of assignments. He is involved in coordinating and implementing the smoking policy for state government buildings, drafting the health care reform bill and staying on top of various lottery issues.

Mulloy attended the economic summit called by President-Elect Bill Clinton and charged all of us, regardless of political persuasion, to join the Clinton Administration in stopping run-away spending, helping to end the national deficit, and reforming this country's health care system.

Mulloy discussed Kentucky's financial outlook, and said that we fared better during the national recession than many other states, and he predicted a relatively strong economic growth for the state.

Fellow Rotarian Carol M. Palmore, Secretary of the Labor Cabinet, was guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club for Wednesday January 20, 1993.

Ms. Palmore's presentation focused on the future of the United States workforce in the ever changing global economy. For reference purposes, Ms. Palmore cited the book America's Choice: High Skills or Low Wages in order to explain the deterioration of the United States labor force.

Ms. Palmore state that the following changes need to be made in order for America to be globally competitive:

- 1 - reeducats corporate America about the shortage/need of skilled labor;
- 2 - move away from the typical "top down management" styles;
- 3 - due to the declining birth-rate (since the 1960's) we can no longer afford to have educational throwaways; and,
- 4 - corporate America, labor, education and government must work cooperatively for a more highly skilled technical workforce.

**THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM**

Today's speaker was Vic Hellard, Director, Legislative Research Commission. He stated that the LRC is governed by 16 members of the General Assembly who are legislative leaders of both parties and they select the director. The LRC employs 240 people, 97 of whom are involved in the drafting of legislation and regulations. They also review personal service contracts. The LRC does those things they are directed to do by the legislature. Starting this Monday there will be a Special Session on Ethics. Two more special sessions will follow on health care and the Attorney General's child abuse legislation. The draft proposal on ethics covers the legislative and executive branches as well as local governments. The final version may only cover the legislature and its staff however. On other subjects, Vic said that a constitutional amendment on term limits was unlikely. On the smoking issue, he said that legislators were concerned about limits on smoking in public buildings because this could send a signal throughout the country that Kentucky is attacking its own. Legislators are concerned about the economic impact on Kentucky tobacco farmers.
