THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Four of our fellow Rotarians spoke on memorable experiences they had in Rotary. Jim Graves spoke about his experiences as a team leader of the group study exchange to Korea. From now on the age limit will no longer be 25-35 but is open to non-Rotarians of all ages. Korea now has the first non-military leader since it was founded. Students study from 8 to 5 Monday through Saturday and many study until 10 and on Sundays. Parents often hire private tutors. Jim was in Korea at the time of the International Convention. Pacific Rim countries are Rotary supporters. The next visiting team will be here in April.

Barry Holder spoke about making up in various cities around the country and the world. The oldest club is in Chicago and the second oldest is in San Francisco where he met a Rotarian with 60 years perfect attendance. The friendliest club was in Austria where he was introduced to all the club members and the meeting lasted over 3 hours.

Bill Miller said that Rotary enhances communication and understanding. Rotary makes for friendships which endure over the years. Rotary also provides services in the country and around the world. On April 22-23, four thousand Rotarians will go to the U.N. to discuss local and international problems.

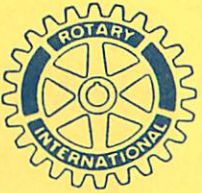

Dr. Frank C. Miller, Chairman of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, University of Kentucky Medical Center and son-in-law of fellow Rotarian Hub Perdew, was the guest speaker of the Frankfort Rotary Club for Wednesday, February 17, 1993.

Dr. Miller was appointed Chairman of the Center for Women's Health in September 1990. The Center has experienced significant growth to better serve all Kentuckians in providing comprehensive, state-of-the-art health care services in gynecology, gynecologic oncology, maternal-fetal medicine, reproductive endocrinology and general obstetrics.

There are four main divisions in the center for Women's Health. The Division of Gynecologic Oncology specializes in the evaluation and treatment of ovarian cancer. This may include radical reconstructive operations, chemotherapy and radiation therapies. The Division of Maternal-Fetal Medicine provides extensive services for women experiencing high-risk pregnancies. Genetic evaluations can also be done through the division's Prenatal Diagnosis Genetic Counseling Service. The Obstetrics and Gynecology - are vital in their screening and treatment of menstrual disorders, infertility and endocrine problems.

Thank you Dr. Miller for providing the latest information from the Center for Women's Health at the University of Kentucky Chandler Medical Center.

THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM

Dr. Mary Smith, president, Kentucky State University spoke about developing a positive relationship between the community and the university. The community must work hand in hand with the university. KSU is a valuable resource to Frankfort. Colleges and Universities exist to serve society. Students are prepared to be contributing participants in the community, state and nation. Once students leave, they should return to benefit their community. Dr. Smith asked why it has been difficult for the community and university to work hand in hand? The answer is that there has been a lack of communication between the two. Information often is not shared which has led to mistrust by both. Then one mistrust another, they avoid each other which leads to more lack of communication. In the 1970's, the Franklin County Community Education Board was established. Community-based groups were encouraged to use University facilities. In January, 1992, a preliminary needs assessment was done. A Franklin County United Way needs assessment was reviewed. Personal and telephone contacts have been made to find out how KSU could assist the Frankfort and Franklin County school systems. A task force under Ed Powe will give Dr. Smith recommendations on how to improve the community and university communications. Dr. Smith personally extended an invitation to everyone to tour the university.
